The list below is a guideline for the projects/programs the Sebastian Hunter Memorial Trust are currently raising funds for. Money goes much further in India, and any donation, no matter how large, can be a huge help to many different lives in Tamil Nadu. You can find full descriptions of the projects/programs after the list.

### ***Toy Fund***

The toy fund will be used to buy and maintain toys and sports equipment for the students and children primarily at the MBKG Orphanage.

### ***Clothing Fund***

The clothing fund supplies the children (ages 0-21) with new clothes which are a very rare necessity. Donations of physical clothes or money to buy clothes are welcome.

### ***Book Fund***

The book fund supplies children's/young adult's books for the secondary schools. Donations of physical books or money to buy books are welcome.

### ***Seb's School, Senji Mottur***

There is no toilet block for the students and staff at Seb's School. We are currently raising funds for this and hope to start building the block asap. The students are also in need of new school uniforms and supplies.

### ***The Sebastian Hunter Higher Secondary School***

A fourth block is planned to be built at the Sebastian Hunter Higher Secondary School with facilities for both art and sport. A toilet block for the female students & staff is also desperately needed.

Individual support for the children from poorer backgrounds to continue their education is also needed. For a three year college or university course, the cost comes to approximately £3,000.

### ***Joshua Brearley Higher Secondary Science Block***

The next phase of this project is to fully equip the labs in the building.

### ***De Valois Primary School***

The Sebastian Hunter Trust would like to find a donor/s who are willing to fund a computer room or library. We would also like to buy shoes for every student.

### ***Kings School & MBKG Orphanage***

#### ***Lunch Fund***

Provides lunch every day for a student, six days a week, for the school year. For most, this is the only meal they get for that day.

#### ***Meal Donation***

Sponsored meals for the entire school can be meat or vegetarian according to the donor's wishes, and can vary in cost depending on what you choose to give them.

#### ***Orphanage Child Sponsorships***

Most children at the MBKG orphanage are sponsored, either by private donors or by large organizations. Sponsorships can be paid either as a one off payment for the year, or through a standing order with any international bank.

#### ***Grandparent Sponsorships***

The Elderly residents at MBKG often find it much harder than the children to find the support they need to live out their lives. Sponsoring one of the 'grandparents' at MBKG gives them access to basic healthcare, food, clothing, a home and a family.

#### ***School Child Sponsorship***

Many of the children who attend Kings School come from severe poverty and struggle to find money for their school fees. Keeping these children in school and improving their life prospects is crucial not only to them, but also to the future wealth and aspirations of their community.

#### ***Medical Fund***

The medical fund supplies day to day health provision and coverage of any emergencies to the children and elderly at the orphanage.

### ***Thandayankottai & Thattankuttai Villages***

We are looking for a donor/s to help pay the salaries for two teachers at the Thattankuttai School as well as funds for 50 children's uniforms and sports equipment for the school.
